CEN/TC 10 - Lifts, escalators and moving walks

EN 81-3 / EN 81-31

WT1 has been incorporated into WG13

- The working document is completed, currently under examination at WG1
- Activities partially suspended for the moment
- WG13: at least 2/3 meetings will be needed to allow WG13 and its members to know in detail the activities of the former WG1-WT1.



CEN/TC 10 - Lifts, escalators and moving walks

prEN 81-42

- The text of the standard is now completed
- The text of Annex ZA is now completed
- The safety values for the Performance Level (PLs) have been inserted in table #11 - Electric Safety Devices.



The document can be sent to CEN for the start of the final approval phase.



Machinery Directive WG

2019 Activities

- Participation as SBS/EFESME expert
- **December meeting, approval of the minutes:** lift platforms without cabin doors travelling in automatically do not comply with the Machinery Directive
- **EFESME/SBS article** written on the topic
 - <u>Are "Lifting Platforms" becoming more and more popular, and can they still be</u>
 <u>safe?</u>

A second article is in the pipeline



Machinery Directive WG

2020 Activities

- Participation as SBS/EFESME expert
- Different national positions on how to potentially update the Directive
- Topics of interest for the sector:
 - Artificial intelligence and cybersecurity
 - Insertion in the text of the Directive of the installer for some machines (stairlift)
 - Platform speed (increase to 0.5m/s seems already abandoned)
 - Documentation for the customer
 - Positions for/against digital documentation only
 - If infrastructure is lacking, potential problem for SMEs
