At the EU standardisation level, **the EN 81 series is currently under revision** by CEN TC 10.

The EN 81 series is the group of standards that drives the European lift industry.

The new version of 81-20 e 81-50 are the backbone of the incoming ISO 8100-1 and ISO 8100-2.


**EFESME is actively working with its experts and SBS** to ensure that the revised standards are **SME-friendly**.


